REVOCATION REVIEW (CASE 567)

CERTAIN HOLLOW STRUCTURAL SECTIONS EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA FROM THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA BY HISTEEL CO LTD

File Note - Withdrawal of Application

This file note is published to seek submissions from all interested parties in respect of the application to initiate a revocation review made by HiSteel Co Ltd (HiSteel) on 2 September 2020.

Background

On 1 October 2020, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published *Consideration Report No. 567* which indicated that there appeared to be reasonable grounds to proceed with HiSteel's application for revocation of the anti-dumping measures as they apply to its exports of hollow structural sections (HSS, or the goods). The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) initiated the present revocation review on the same date (Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2020/109 refers).

On 23 October 2020, HiSteel notified the Commission in writing that it proposed to withdraw its application. The deadline for HiSteel to provide a response to the exporter questionnaire expired on 21 November 2020; no response was received. The Commission understands that HiSteel will not provide any further information or evidence to assist its case for revocation.

Proposed Approach

The Commission proposes to cease consideration of whether the measures, as they apply to HiSteel, should be revoked. The Commission notes that the variable factors relevant to HSS exported by HiSteel are currently the subject of a separate review of measures (case number 529 refers), the final report for which is due to be provided to the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology by 8 February 2021.

If any interested party wishes to make a submission regarding this case and the proposed approach, please do so by no later than **12 February 2021**. If no concerns are raised, in accordance with the Commissioner's incidental powers under section 269SMG of the *Customs Act 1901*, the Commissioner will cease consideration of whether the measures should be revoked.
