



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2021/27

Hollow structural sections exported from the Republic of Korea by HiSteel Co., Ltd

Cessation of a Review of Anti-Dumping Measures No. 567

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 1 October 2020, I published a notice announcing the initiation of a review of the anti-dumping measures (the review) applying to certain hollow structural sections (the goods) exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea (Korea) by HiSteel Co., Ltd (HiSteel).

HiSteel submitted that the measures applying to its exports of the goods are no longer warranted. A full description of the goods and the current anti-dumping measures is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2020/109 on the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) website at www.adcommission.gov.au.

On 23 October 2020, HiSteel notified the Commission in writing that it proposed to withdraw its application. The deadline for HiSteel to provide a response to the exporter questionnaire expired on 21 November 2020. HiSteel did not submit a questionnaire response, and represented that it did not intend to provide any further information or evidence to assist its case for revocation.

Having regard for these matters, on 29 January 2021, the Commission published a file note advising interested parties of my intention to cease consideration of the review, and I invited interested parties to make submissions in response by 12 February 2021. No submissions were received by that deadline. I received a late submission from HiSteel on 16 February 2021, which represented that it did not have sufficient accounting resources to submit the questionnaire.

In accordance with my incidental powers under section 269SMG of the *Customs Act 1901*, I have ceased consideration of whether the measures should be revoked. HiSteel may re-apply for a revocation review at a later date in accordance with the legislated timeframes set out in Division 5, Part XVB of the *Customs Act 1901*.
