# **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2022/056**

## **Quenched and tempered steel plate Exported from the United States of America Investigation No 578 into alleged dumping Extension of time granted to issue the Final Report**

*Customs Act 1901 (Cth) - Part XVB<sup>1</sup>*

On 15 March 2021, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (Commissioner) published a notice (initiation notice) initiating an investigation into the alleged dumping of quenched and tempered steel plate exported to Australia from the United States of America.<sup>2</sup>

The initiation notice advised that the Commissioner would publish a statement of essential facts (SEF) on the public record by 3 July 2021. The initiation notice also advised that the Commissioner would make a recommendation to the Minister in a report on or before 17 August 2021.

The Commissioner extended the due dates to publish the SEF and provide the final report to the Minister. The Commissioner published the SEF on the public record on 22 April 2022.<sup>3</sup> The Commissioner was due to make a recommendation to the Minister in a report on or before 16 June 2022.

To allow time for the Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission) to consider relevant issues raised in recent submissions, I, Isolde Lueckenhausen, General Manager (Investigations) of the commission, requested an extension of the due date for the Commissioner to provide the report and recommendation to the Minister.

The Commissioner has, under section 269ZHI(3) of the Act, extended the due date to provide his final report and recommendation.

The Commissioner is now due to provide the final report and recommendation to the Minister on or before **4 August 2022**, unless terminated on this date or earlier.
