



# **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO 2021/154**

## **Copper tube**

### **Exported to Australia from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam**

### **Investigation No 580 into alleged dumping**

### **Extension of time granted to issue the Final Report**

*Customs Act 1901 (Cth) – Part XVB*

On 22 March 2021, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of copper tube (the goods) exported to Australia from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Vietnam).

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No 2021/41 available on the Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission) website at [www.adcommission.gov.au](http://www.adcommission.gov.au) (initiation notice).

The initiation notice relevantly advised that a recommendation to the Minister for Industry, Energy and Emissions Reduction (the Minister) would be made in a final report on, or before, 24 August 2021. The Commissioner previously extended these deadlines.<sup>1</sup> The statement of essential facts (SEF) was published on the public record on 29 October 2021.<sup>2</sup> The Commissioner is due to give the Minister a final report with his findings and recommendations arising from the investigation on or before 13 December 2021.

In order to fully consider issues raised in interested parties' submissions in response to the SEF, I, Isolde Lueckenhausen, General Manager, Investigations of the commission, requested an extension of the deadline for the Commissioner to provide his final report and recommendations to the Minister.<sup>3</sup>

The Commissioner has, under section 269ZHI(3) of the Act, extended the deadline to provide the final report and recommendations.<sup>4</sup>

A recommendation to the Minister will now be made in a report due on, or before, **25 February 2022**, unless terminated on this date or earlier.
