Dear Sir /Madam ,

Reference to your letter dated 27th April 2021, we (EMIRATES FLOAT GLASS LLC, Abu Dhabi, U.A.E) hereby submit our response regarding the alleged dumping of clear float glass exported from U.A.E

Emirates Float Glass (EFG) were very surprised to receive a letter from the Anti-Dumping commission accusing us for causing damage and injury to the local producer, due to the **very low volume** we have supplied the Australian market during March 2020 and March 2021. In fact, between the period of October 2020 and March 2021, EFG **hardly shipped any Clear Float into Australia.**

EFG only entered the Australian market after being approached by domestic manufacturers who couldn't get any local Clear Float supply due to tight capacity. EFG has **only supplied a handful of customers who could not get any support from the domestic supplier** and in no way, this has caused any damage nor injury.

With only 1 float plant in Australia & New Zealand, the Australian market heavily depends on overseas support for raw material (Clear Float). **In fact, the local glass producer has circulated a letter to the market earlier this year confirming the tight capacity that will lead to a short supply.**

Finally, **we presume the Anti-Dumping submission should not be made against a particular region or country but should be submitted against individual companies.**

Please consider the above factual response from our side and exclude EFG from further investigation. We are **ready to support with any additional information the Commission would require** as deemed necessary for this exclusion request.
