Firstly we appreciate the commissions patience. Whilst we respect the process of Australian Manufacturers submitting to the ADC as in the case of the Investigation 583 we are unable to make a final submission. We have seen continuous Dumping requests form Paper Australia and must now consider Dumping as their main and only strategy. Paper Australia's management have failed to address the ongoing structural decline from both technology and COVID, the change and consolidation in the channel to market and overcapacity without a structured export strategy.

To then overlay an onerous and highly detailed questionnaire at this time finds both ourselves and our Supplier in a position where we have no choice but to inform the Commission that we will be unable to respond at this time.
