



INVESTIGATION INTO THE ALLEGED DUMPING (CASE 584)

MERCHANT BAR EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA FROM TAIWAN

File Note - Extension of time for Questionnaire Responses

On 31 May 2021, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission published *Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2021/073* (ADN No. 2021/073) announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of merchant bar exported from Taiwan.

This initiation notice advised that responses to the exporter questionnaire for the investigation are requested by 7 July 2021. The Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) received requests for extensions of time to the due date from certain exporters within the legislated period, who have communicated their intent to cooperate with the investigation.

Due consideration has been given to the extension requests by the General Manager of the Commission, having regard to the exporters' individual circumstances and the *Customs (Extensions of Time and Non-cooperation) Direction 2015*.¹

The following table summarises the extensions of time given in relation to individual exporters and provides a summary of the revised due dates:

E-Sheng Steel Co., Ltd	21	28 July 2021
