**Investigation No 584 into the alleged dumping of certain

Staff of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission) met with representatives of InfraBuild NSW Pty Ltd (InfraBuild) virtually on 8 March 2022.

InfraBuild requested the meeting to further present to the commission on its submission of 24 February 2022.¹

In its submission, InfraBuild contends that the exporter-specific MCC category of 'standard' is not based on any physical characteristic, and does not facilitate a consistent approach across exporters in assessing which goods sold domestically are most alike to the exported goods.

InfraBuild also contends that the price effect of differences in size is limited, and it is not possible to isolate this effect from other factors.
