



Reinvestigation of certain findings in relation to Continuation Inquiry No. 591 relating to certain aluminium extrusions exported from Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam

File Note

On 24 June 2021, the Minister for Industry and Science (Minister) accepted the recommendations of the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (Commissioner) following continuation inquiry 591. This inquiry considered whether the continuation of the anti-dumping measures in the form of a dumping duty notice (Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Vietnam)) and a countervailing duty notice (Malaysia only) applying to certain aluminium extrusions exported to Australia from Malaysia and Vietnam was justified. The findings and recommendations from the continuation inquiry are set out in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No. 591* (REP 591).

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) is conducting a review of the Minister's decision under section 269ZHG(1)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) not to secure the continuation of the anti-dumping measures concerned, having received an application for a review from Capral Limited.

Pursuant to section 269ZZL of the Act, the ADRP has requested that the Anti-Dumping Commission (commission) reinvestigate certain findings in REP 591. Further details and information regarding the ADRP's reinvestigation request are available on the ADRP's website at www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.

The commission proposes to publish a preliminary reinvestigation report (PRR) on the commission's electronic public record in due course. The commission will invite interested parties to make submissions in response to the Commissioner's preliminary findings within 14 days of publishing the PRR. Submissions received within the 14 day period will inform the preparation of the reinvestigation report the Commissioner will provide to the ADRP.

The Commissioner is currently due to provide the reinvestigation report to the ADRP by 10 February 2023.
