***RE: Continuation Inquiry No 591 –Exports of Aluminium Extrusions from Malaysia and Vietnam –
Reinvestigation - Extension***

As you know, I act for Press Metal Aluminium Australia Pty Limited (**PMAA**) and for its related bodies corporate, including PMB Aluminium Sdn Bhd (**PMBA**), in relation to Continuation Inquiry 591 (**Inquiry**) and the reinvestigation requested by the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (**ADRP**).

I refer to the **attached** letter from you to Panel Member, Ms Jaclyne Fisher, of 12 January 2023 requesting an extension of time within which to report to Ms Fisher on the reinvestigation and the **attached** letter from Ms Fisher dated 16 January 2023 granting you an extension of 82 days to 3 May 2023, both of which have been placed on the ADRP's public file.

Neither letter has been placed on the Anti-Dumping Commission's (**Commission**) public file, nor has a notice been issued advising of the extension of time granted in respect of the reinvestigation. Nor has there been a response to either of my submissions in the reinvestigation concerning the conduct of the reinvestigation.
