# **ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO 2022/009**

## **Zinc Coated (Galvanised) Steel**

### **Exported from the Republic of India, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam**

#### **Extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts and the Final Report in relation to Continuation Inquiry No. 592**

*Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB*

On 6 October 2021, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (Commissioner) published a notice initiating an inquiry into the continuation of anti-dumping measures in respect of zinc coated (galvanised) steel exported to Australia from the Republic of India, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (initiation notice).<sup>1</sup>

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) would be placed on the public record on or before 24 January 2022. The initiation notice also advised that a recommendation to the Minister for Industry, Energy and Emissions Reduction (the Minister) would be made in a final report on or before 10 March 2022.

In order to fully assess and verify the information provided by interested parties in this inquiry, I, Justin Wickes, Acting General Manager, Anti-Dumping Commission, requested an extension of the deadline for the Commissioner to publish the SEF and provide his final report and recommendation to the Minister.<sup>2</sup>

The Commissioner has, under section 269ZHI(3) of the *Customs Act 1901*,<sup>3</sup> extended the deadline to publish the SEF and provide his final report and recommendation to the Minister.

A recommendation to the Minister will now be made in a report due on or before **1 July 2022**.
