



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2022/063

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

Zinc Coated (Galvanised) Steel

**Exported to Australia from the Republic of India, Malaysia and
the Socialist Republic of Vietnam**

Findings of Continuation Inquiry No. 592

Notice under section 269ZHG(1) of the Customs Act 1901

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) has completed an inquiry, which commenced on 6 October 2021, into whether the continuation of the anti-dumping measures applying to zinc coated (galvanised) steel exported to Australia from the Republic of India (India), Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Vietnam) is justified.

The anti-dumping measures are in the form of a dumping duty notice applying to galvanised steel exported to Australia from India, Malaysia and Vietnam,¹ and a countervailing duty notice applying to galvanised steel exported to Australia from India.

The Commissioner's recommendations resulting from the inquiry, reasons for the recommendations, and material findings of fact and law in relation to the inquiry are contained in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No. 592 (REP 592)*.

I, ED HUSIC, the Minister for Industry and Science, have considered REP 592 and have decided to accept the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations, including all material findings of facts and law set out in REP 592.

Under section 269ZHG(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), I declare that I have decided to secure the continuation of the anti-dumping measures:

- in the form of a dumping duty notice applying to galvanised steel exported to Australia from India, Malaysia and Vietnam, and
- in the form of a countervailing duty notice applying to galvanised steel exported to Australia from India.

In accordance with section 269ZHG(4)(a)(i) of the Act, I determine that the dumping duty notice and the countervailing duty notice continue in force after 16 August 2022 (the specified expiry date).

¹ The dumping duty notice does not apply to goods exported to Australia from Vietnam by Hoa Sen Group and Nam Kim Steel Joint Stock Company.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (www.adreviewpanel.gov.au), in accordance with the requirements in Division 9 of Part XVB of the Act, within 30 days of the publication of this notice.
