Tariff Classification

The goods the subject of the anti-dumping measures are zinc coated (galvanized) steel products, classified within tariff sub-headings 7210.49.00 (statistical codes 55, 56, 57, and 58), 7212.30.00 (statistical code 61), 7225.92.00 (statistical code 38), and 7226.99.00 (statistical code 71). Specifically, the subject goods are zinc coated sheets and coils, whether or not containing alloys, of any width.

Countries/companies the subject of the measures

The current anti-dumping measures, in the form of the below referenced Dumping Duty Notice, apply to zinc coated (galvanized) steel exported to Australia from India, Malaysia, and Vietnam (“the Dumping Duty Notice”).

The applicant seeks a continuation of this *Dumping Duty Notice* as it applies to all exporters of the goods exported to Australia from the above-noted countries, except for:

- exports from Vietnam by the Hoa Sen Group, and Nam Kim Steel Joint Stock Company, to which interim dumping duties do not apply.

Date of publication of the measures

The relevant *Dumping Duty Notice* is ADN No. 2017/99, published 16 August 2017.
