



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO 2022/101

Hot rolled coil steel

Exported from Taiwan

Extension of time granted to issue the final report in relation to Continuation Inquiry 594

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 4 January 2022, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (Commissioner) published a notice announcing the initiation of an inquiry into whether the continuation of anti-dumping measures in respect of hot rolled coil steel exported to Australia from Taiwan is justified.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No 2022/02 (initiation notice). The initiation notice is available on the Anti-Dumping Commission's (Commission) website at www.adcommission.gov.au.

The initiation notice advised that a recommendation to the Minister for Industry and Science (the Minister) would be made in a final report on or before 8 June 2022. The Commissioner extended the due date to provide the final report to the Minister to 12 October 2022.¹

To fully consider the matters raised in submissions following the publication of the statement of essential facts, I, Mayuran Jeyarajah, Acting Deputy Commissioner, Investigations, Anti-Dumping Commission, requested a further extension of the deadline for the Commissioner to provide his final report and recommendation to the Minister.²

The Commissioner has, under section 269ZHI(3) of the *Customs Act 1901*,³ extended the deadline to provide his final report and recommendation. A recommendation to the Minister will now be made in a report due on or before 9 November 2022.
