BACKGROUND

Why you have been asked to fill out this information request

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commissioner) is conducting a review of the anti-dumping measures for aluminium extrusions exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China).

Please refer to Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2022/081 and electronic public record 609 on the Anti-Dumping Commission (the commission) website (www.adcommission.gov.au) for a detailed description of the goods and more information about the review process.

Given the large number of exporters of the goods to Australia, it is not practical for the Commissioner to examine the entire population of exports. Accordingly, the Commissioner intends to carry out this review on the basis of information that will be obtained from a detailed examination of a sample of exporters that together provide the bulk of the exports to Australia. Your company is not part of this sample.

Your company has however been identified as a potential supplier of the goods the subject of this review. The Commissioner requests that you make yourself known to the commission and provide a basic level of information, via an information request and associated spreadsheets.

What happens if you do not respond to the information request and associated spreadsheets?

You are under no obligation to complete this information request.

However, it is important you understand that if you do not respond to this information request, the commission will be precluded from investigating your situation and may consider that your company did not cooperate with the review.

In that case the review will proceed using all other relevant information. For example, the commission will determine an export price, normal value and an amount of countervailable subsidy for your company based on available facts. This may include information submitted by the Australian industry. As such, the result may be less favourable to your company than if you respond to the information request and associated spreadsheets and are willing to cooperate with the review.

What happens if you do respond to this information request and associated spreadsheets?

If you complete and return all relevant parts of this information request and associated spreadsheets, the Commissioner will regard your company as a residual exporter. In addition, the Commissioner may assess your response and decide whether or not your company should be included in as part of a sample for further investigation.

If the Commissioner selects your company for further investigation, and your company fully cooperates with the commission's inquiries including completing an exporter questionnaire and allowing the Commission to conduct a verification of your response, variable factors may be determined for your company based on your company's own data as relevant.

Alternatively, if your company is not selected for further investigation, the commission will calculate variable factors having regard to relevant information supplied by those exporters who are part of the sampled exporters and cooperate with the review.

It is in your company's interest, therefore, to complete all relevant parts of this information request and associated spreadsheets and return them to the Commission by the due date **14 September 2022**.
