Tariff Classification

The goods the subject of the anti-dumping measures are aluminium zinc coated steel products, classified within tariff sub-headings 7210.61.00 (statistical codes 60, 61, and 62). Specifically, the subject goods are flat rolled products of iron and non-alloy steel, of a width equal to or greater than 600 millimetres (**mm**), plated or coated with aluminium zinc alloys, not painted, and whether or not including resin coating.

Countries/companies the subject of the measures

The current anti-dumping measures, in the form of the below referenced Dumping Duty Notice, apply to AlZn coated steel exported to Australia from China.

BlueScope seeks continuation of the measures as they apply to all exporters of the goods exported to Australia from China.

Period of Review

The applicant for this review nominates a review period of twelve months ending 30 June 2022 (**FY2022**).

Date of publication of the measures

The relevant *Dumping Duty Notice* is ACDN No. 2013/66, published 5 August 2013.

Industry financial data must, wherever possible, be submitted in an electronic format.
