## 3. Matters discussed:

- Background to the investigation, key reporting dates, submission process and public record requirements.
- Myles Stewart (Apparent / Aqronomiq) provided a presentation titled "Agronomiq: Anti-Dumping Duty on Fully-Formulated (FF) Glyphosate Imported From China -Agrichem Manufacturing Industries Pty Ltd T/A Agronomig Presentation to Australian Customs and Border Protection Service, Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2012".
