

AUSTRALIAN CUSTOMS DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2012/36

Minister for Home Affairs re-appoints Acting Trade Measures Review Officer

On Friday 6 July 2012, the Minister for Home Affairs Jason Clare re-appointed Stephen Skehill as acting Trade Measures Review Officer (TMRO).

The TMRO reviews certain decisions of the Minister and Chief Executive Officer of Customs and Border Protection under the *Customs Act 1901* in relation to dumping and subsidy investigations, reviews and continuations.

Legislation is currently before the Parliament to enact the Government's plans to replace the TMRO with a panel of members as part of the Government's improvements to the anti-dumping system.

In the interim, to ensure reviews are conducted in a timely manner, Mr Skehill will act under the current arrangements for independent review set out in the Customs Act.

Mr Skehill is a former Australian Government Solicitor and former Secretary of the Commonwealth Attorney-General's Department.
