

ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2013/93 Import Data Financial Assistance Program

Anti-Dumping Commission funding for the purchase of ABS data

Australian manufacturers and producers intending to lodge an application for anti-dumping or countervailing measures, or an application for an anti-circumvention inquiry, are able to apply to the Anti-Dumping Commission to obtain relevant import data from the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) free of charge. If approved, the Anti-Dumping Commission will fund the ABS to provide data to an approved applicant, at no cost to the approved applicant.

ABS import data is a source of trade statistics that can be used in applications to the Anti-Dumping Commission for anti-dumping or countervailing measures, or for anticircumvention inquiries.

The Import Data Financial Assistance Program facilitates better access to import data which Australian producers and manufacturers may require to effectively utilise Australia's anti-dumping system.

The program is available to Australian businesses of all sizes that meet the eligibility criteria provided in the program guidelines. To apply for import data assistance, Australian manufacturers and producers are required to submit an application to the Commission. The guidelines provide details regarding eligibility criteria, information on how to complete the application form, the process and the data available under the program.
