ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2016/32

Publishing additional information on Duty Assessment cases

Purpose

The purpose of this Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) is to advise interested parties that the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) will publish additional information on duty assessment cases in future monthly status reports.

Background

The Commission publishes a monthly report which advises interested parties on the status of anti-dumping and countervailing actions that are being undertaken by the Commission (status report). The status report contains information on duty assessment cases, including case number, type of application (dumping and/or countervailing), date the duty assessment application was received, due date of the final report to the Parliamentary Secretary, and the status of each case.

Additional information

To ensure greater consistency with reporting of other anti-dumping and countervailing actions, and to improve transparency, future status reports will contain additional duty assessment case information. This includes:

- The goods to which the application relates;
- Name of the importer of the goods;
- Country of origin of the imported goods; and
- Details of the importation period for which an importer is requesting a duty assessment.
