



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2022/028

Hollow structural sections

Exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan

Second extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts and the Final Report in relation to Continuation Inquiry No 590

Customs Act 1901 (Cth) – Part XVB

On 22 September 2021, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (Commissioner) published a notice initiating an inquiry into the continuation of anti-dumping measures in respect of hollow structural sections exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan (initiation notice).¹

The initiation notice advised that the Commissioner would publish the statement of essential facts (SEF) on the public record no later than 10 January 2022. The initiation notice also advised that the Commissioner would make a recommendation to the Minister for Industry, Energy and Emissions Reduction (the Minister) in a final report no later than 24 February 2022.

As advised in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No 2022/004, the Commissioner extended the due dates to publish the SEF and provide the final report to the Minister to 23 March 2022 and 13 May 2022 respectively.

Due to the complexity of this inquiry and to allow the commission to finalise verification activities, I, Isolde Lueckenhausen, General Manager of the commission, requested an extension of the due date for the Commissioner to publish the SEF and provide his final report and recommendation to the Minister.²

The Commissioner has, under section 269ZHI(3) of the *Customs Act 1901 (Cth)* (the Act), extended the due date to publish the SEF and provide his final report and

recommendation to the Minister.

The Commissioner is now due to publish a SEF on the public record no later than 20 April 2022 and provide his final report and recommendation to the Minister no later than 1 June 2022.
