



ANTI- DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2014/125

Certain Hollow Structural Sections Exported from the Kingdom of Thailand

Extension of time granted to issue the Statement of Essential Facts

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

On 21 July 2014, the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping of certain hollow structural sections (HSS) exported to Australia from the Kingdom of Thailand.

A full description of the goods is available in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No. 2014/59 which is available on the Commission's website at www.adcommission.gov.au.

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the investigation would be placed on the public record by 10 November 2014. The SEF will set out the facts on which I propose to base recommendations to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry (the Parliamentary Secretary) in relation to the investigation.

Due to the continuing heavy workload of the Commission, I requested an extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The Parliamentary Secretary has, under section 269ZH1 of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than **6 February 2015**. Interested parties will be invited to make submissions to the Commission in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Parliamentary Secretary will now be made in a report due on or before 23 March 2015.
