The exemption goods:

The goods for which the exemption is being sought are Aluminium Angle Line extruded in 7005-T593. These materials are used in the manufacture of Plant Trailers and Loading Ramps, for the transportation and loading of earthmoving equipment.

Exemption being sought for Extruded Aluminium Angles manufactured from Aluminium Alloy designation 7005 with T593 temper designation with the following dimensions:

- 38.1mm x 38.1mm x 4.75mm angle at 6 meters long (sketch no. PE00E2493 attached)
- 40mm x 40mm x 6mm angle at 6 meters long (sketch no. PE00E2371 attached)
- 50.8mm x 50.8mm x 6.35mm angle at 6 meters long (sketch no. PE00E2498 attached)
- 63.5mm x 63.5mm x 6.35mm angle at 6 meters long (sketch no. PE00E2494 attached)
- 76.2mm x 76.2mm x 6.35mm angle at 6 meters long (sketch no. PE00E2496 attached)

Conditions exist that provide grounds to make an exemption for the above-mentioned materials, in that no Australian aluminium extrusion company will produce these materials for the manufacture of Plant Trailers and Loading Ramps.

Grounds on which we are seeking the exemption:

Ground One – Like or directly competitive goods are not offered for sale in Australia to all purchasers on equal terms under like conditions having regard to the custom and usage of trade.

Attached to this application is evidence that all known Australian producers have been contacted in writing and asked whether, or not, they can manufacture and supply goods, the terms of supply.
