



ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE No 2022/078

Withdrawal of application for an exemption from dumping and countervailing duty notices

Certain Aluminium Extrusions exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam

Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975

On 16 July 2021, Dr Bradley Armstrong PSM, the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission, initiated an exemption inquiry following an application from Studform Pty Ltd (the applicant).

The inquiry was in relation to certain aluminium extrusions exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam that are subject to anti-dumping measures.

Advice of the Commissioner's decision to initiate the inquiry and further details concerning the goods for which the exemption was sought were published in Anti-Dumping Notice (ADN) No 2021/093, which is available on the Anti-Dumping Commission website at www.adcommission.gov.au.

On 27 July 2022, the applicant withdrew its application. Accordingly, I have ceased the exemption inquiry. No findings will be made on the exemption of the goods subject to the application.
