Pillar Products Pty Ltd
Application for exemption from dumping duty and countervailing duty
NON-CONFIDENTIAL

We confirm we act for Pillar Products Pty Ltd (**Pillar**).

We are instructed to make an application (the **Application**) for an exemption from dumping and countervailing duty otherwise payable on certain [hollow structural sections](#) imported from the People's Republic of China (**China**) by Pillar.

1 Applicant's details

1.1 We confirm the applicant in relation to this Application is Pillar (the **Applicant**).

(a) Pillar's details are as follows:

1.1 Pillar was established in 2018 and since February 2016, Pillar has sold steel curtain rods in Australia, through hardware store retailer Bunnings Warehouse Group Ltd.

2 Relevant Facts

2.1 In support of this Application, we are instructed as follows:

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- (a) The Applicant has imported and seeks to continue to import hollow structural sections from China, which are used as curtain rods (the **Goods**).

The Applicant has been importing the Goods under tariff heading 7306.30.00.

- (b) Pursuant to sections 8 and 10 of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975 (Anti-Dumping Act)*, the Goods are currently subject to alleged dumping duty and countervailing duty measures, as they have been unintentionally captured within the broad terms of the dumping and countervailing measures that have been in place since approximately 2012 applying to hollow structural sections. Consequently, the Applicant is an affected party.

- (c) The goods subject to measures as described in Dumping Commodity Register found [here](#), are:

“Certain electric resistance welded pipe and tube made of carbon steel, comprising circular and non-circular hollow sections. Normally referred to as either CHS (circular or oval hollow sections) or RHS (rectangular or square hollow sections) collectively referred to as hollow structural sections (HSS), including CHS with other than plain ends, such as threaded, swaged and shouldered.

Finish Types

- *Galvanised (including in-line galvanised (ILG), pre-galvanised or hot-dipped galvanised (HDG)); or*
- *Non-galvanised (including, but not restricted to, painted, black, lacquered or oiled finishes).*

Sizes

- *Circular products – outside diameter exceeding 21 mm up to and including 165.1 mm; or*
- *Oval, square and rectangular products – perimeter up to and including 1277.3 mm; that may also be categorised according to minimum yield strength, the most common classifications being 250 and 350 mega Pascals (MPa).”*

- 2.2 The relevant tariff classifications subject to the dumping duty and countervailing duty measures are:

- (a) 7306.30.00 (statistical codes 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37)
- (b) 7306.61.00 (statistical codes 21, 22, 25)
- (c) 7306.69.00 (statistical codes 10)
- (d) 7306.50.00 (statistical codes 45)

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(e) 7306.61.00 (statistical codes 90)

2.3 For the reasons set out below, the Applicant is of the view that the Goods which it has imported and continues to import should not be subject to dumping and countervailing duty measures as, under subparagraphs 8(7)(a) and 10(8)(a) of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (**Anti-Dumping Act**), like or directly competitive goods are not offered for sale in Australia to all purchasers on equal terms under like conditions having regard to the custom and usage of trade.

2.4 On that basis we would request that an exemption from the dumping and countervailing duty measures be granted in respect of the Goods.

3 The Goods are not Like Goods

The meaning of “like goods” is considered in section 2 of the Department of Industry, Innovation and Science (**Department**) Dumping and Subsidy Manual dated November 2018 (**Dumping Manual**). In our view the Goods are not like goods as described in the Dumping Manual due to the reasons set out below.

3.1 The Goods imported by the Applicant are unique and are not like goods for the purposes of the dumping and countervailing duty measures. The Applicant imports the following curtain rods:

- (a) 25mm outside diameter in 0.5mm gauge/wall thickness in both powder-coated (White/Ivory/Black) and electroplated (Brushed Chrome).
- (b) 32mm outside diameter in 0.7mm gauge/wall thickness in electroplated finish (Brushed Chrome).

3.2 The curtain rods come in lengths 2.0m and 3.0m, and are individually heat/shrink wrapped and labelled. Please refer to attachment 1 and 2 for a photograph of the 25mm and 32mm curtain rods respectively. The curtain rods are made of A class hot-rolled strip metal comprising of 0.12% Carbon and are made using a roll forming process and a longitudinal welding technique.

3.3 The Goods are designed and manufactured for a specific purpose, to be used as curtain rods, and the Goods have no other use apart from being used as curtain rods. Due to their use as curtain rods, the Goods are made with a very thin wall thickness and therefore cannot be used for any alternate purpose. Please see attachment 3 and 4 for a diagram of the 25mm and 32mm curtain rods respectively.

3.4 We are instructed that one of the reasons the Applicant is importing the 25mm curtain rods, is for a specific Queensland Government Tender, where the curtain rods will be used for a Queensland Housing Commission Project. The cost of dumping and countervailing duties was not anticipated as part of the project cost, and it would be counter-productive for such measures to now be sought on the 25mm curtain rods.

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4 Australian Producers

4.1 The Applicant imports the Goods from Foshan Fubosi Hardware Products Factory (**FFHP**), a manufacturer in China, who can produce the Goods. The Applicant was not aware that the Goods may be subject to dumping and countervailing duty measures, and first became aware of such measures when it was contacted by Brett of the Australian Border Force (**ABF**) on 20 August 2021 via email. In the email, Brett wrote, *“given my brief review it would seem that the >21mm will be subject to ADM under hollow Structural Sections”*. The Applicant immediately took action to arrange an exemption application in respect of the Goods.

4.2 We are instructed that there are no other manufacturers in Australia that can produce the Goods. The Applicant has been in contact with potential Australian producers of the Goods including Orrcon Manufacturing Pty Ltd (**Orrcon**) and Australian Rollforming Manufacturers Pty Ltd (**ARM**).

4.3 The Applicant contacted Orrcon on 24 August 2021, asking whether Orrcon can manufacture the Goods and Orrcon responded on 24 August 2021 with the following:

“I am sorry Mate, we don’t even come close to those thickness for you”.

Please refer to attachment 5 for a copy of this email.

4.4 On 6 September 2021, the Applicant emailed ARM, asking whether ARM can manufacture the Goods. ARM responded on 6 September 2021 with the following:

“Unfortunately don’t have the machinery to be able to produce these profiles”.

Please refer to attachment 6 for a copy of this email.

4.5 On 28 September 2021, after Orrcon completed an extensive enquiry into the specification of the Goods (including the review of the diameter, wall thickness, finish, length, packaging and labelling of the Goods), Orrcon emailed the Applicant stating the following:

“Orrcon will not object unreasonably to an application for duty exemption. I am happy to offer our support by providing you with feedback on your description of the goods as part of a duty exemption application”.

Please refer to attachment 7 for a copy of this email trail.

Based on the above, it is clear that Orrcon is in full support of the Applicant’s Application. We are of the view that if the Australian Industry is in support of the Application, there is no reason for the Application to be denied.

4.6 Notwithstanding Investigation 550 by the Anti-Dumping Commission, this is the first time the Applicant has been impacted by dumping and countervailing duty measures of this nature. We are instructed that the Applicant was not contacted nor was the Applicant’s freight forwarder contacted in relation to making a submission for an exemption by the Anti-Dumping Commission in relation to these measures. The

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Applicant advises that if it had been notified of the measures, it would have made appropriate arrangements to apply for an exemption.


- 4.7 In circumstances where the Goods are not like goods and the Australian industry has confirmed that it is not able to manufacture the Goods, we submit that the Goods are not offered for sale in Australia to all purchasers on equal terms under like conditions having regard to the custom and usage of trade and request that an exemption (exemption one) from the measures be granted in respect of the Goods.

5 Conclusions

- 5.1 For the reasons set out above, the Applicant is of the view that the Goods which it has imported and continues to import should not be subject to dumping and countervailing duty as, under subparagraphs 8(7)(a) and 10(8)(a) of the Anti-Dumping Act, like goods are not offered for sale in Australia to all purchasers on equal terms under like conditions having regard to the custom and usage of trade.
- 5.2 We would like to flag with the Anti-Dumping Commission that this exemption application is urgent, as the potential dumping and countervailing duty payable on the Goods have significant ramifications for the Applicant's business, both financially and commercially.

We would be pleased to provide the Anti-Dumping Commission with any further information it may require in consideration of this exemption application.

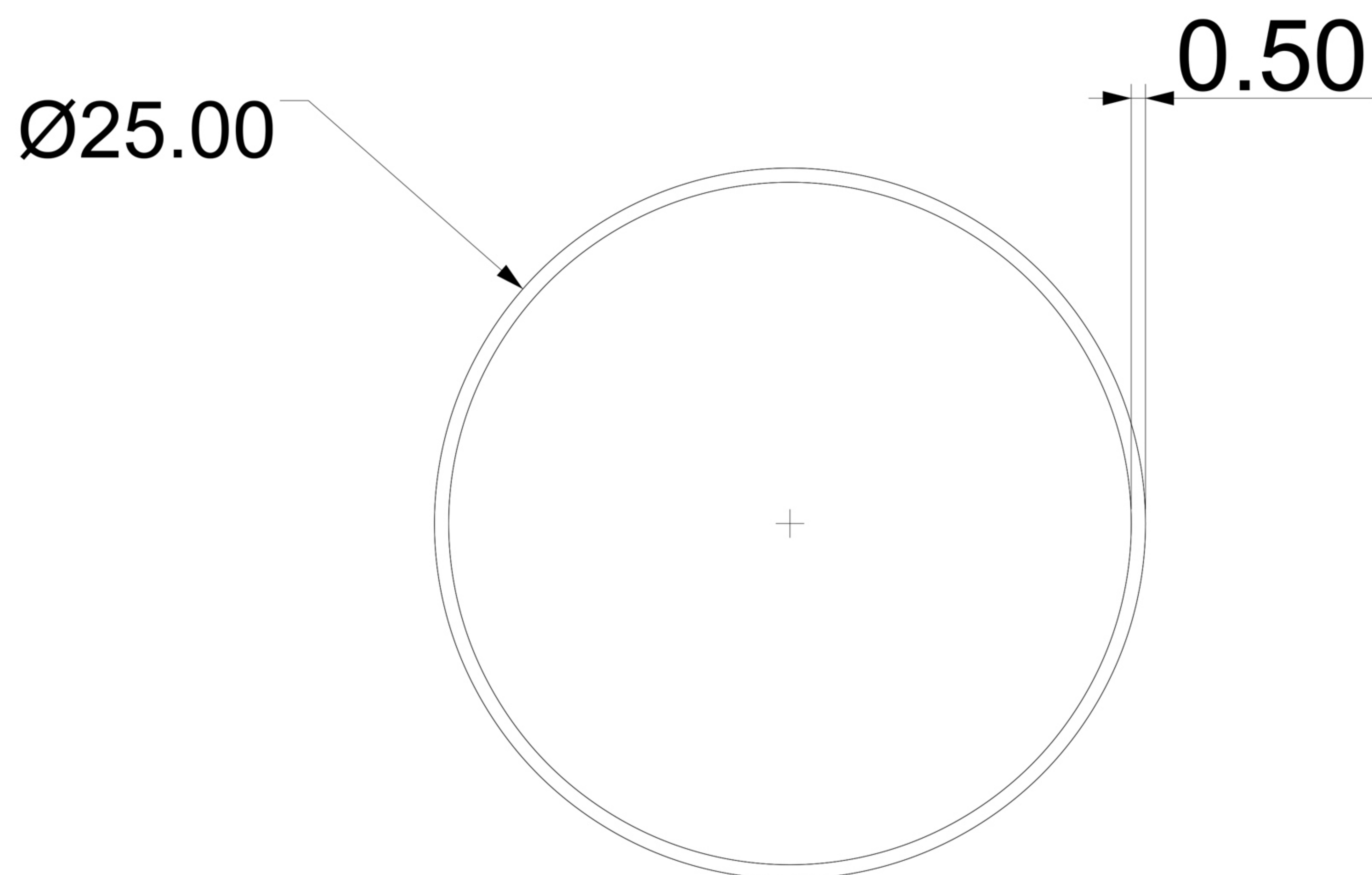
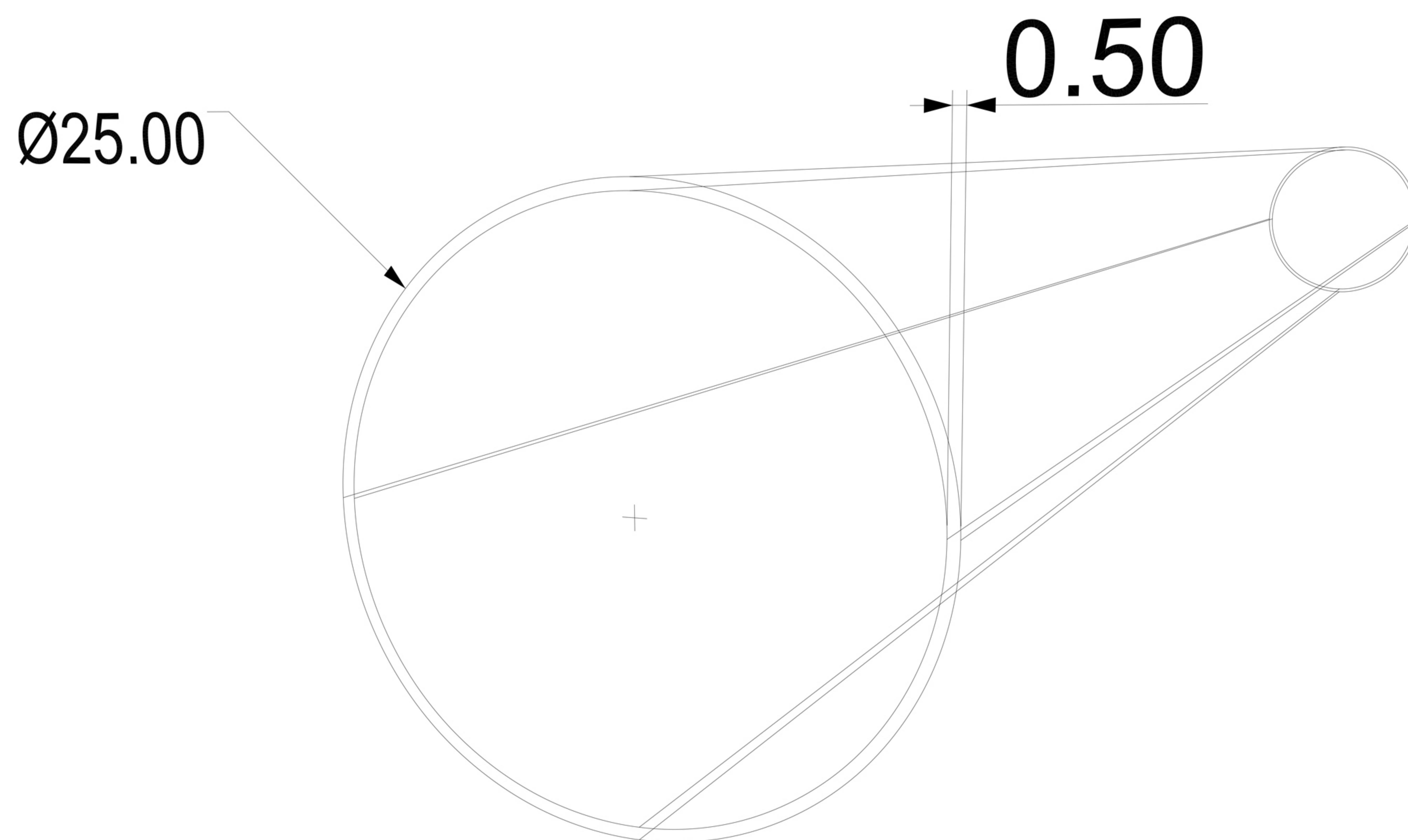
1. Photograph of 25mm curtain rod

2. Diagram of the 25mm curtain rod



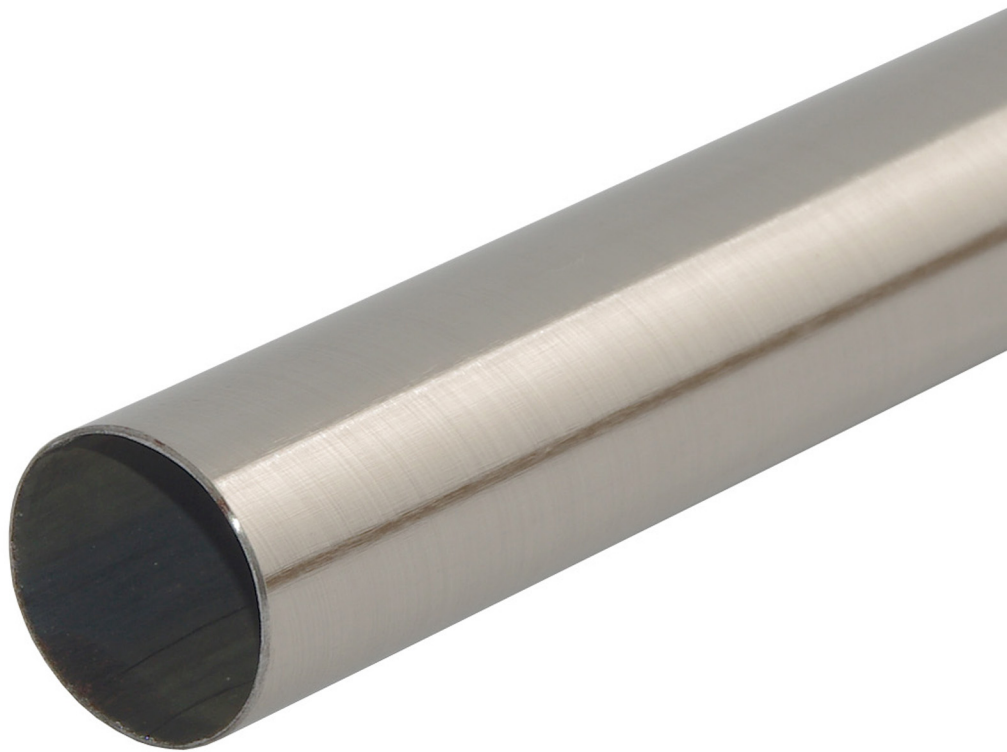

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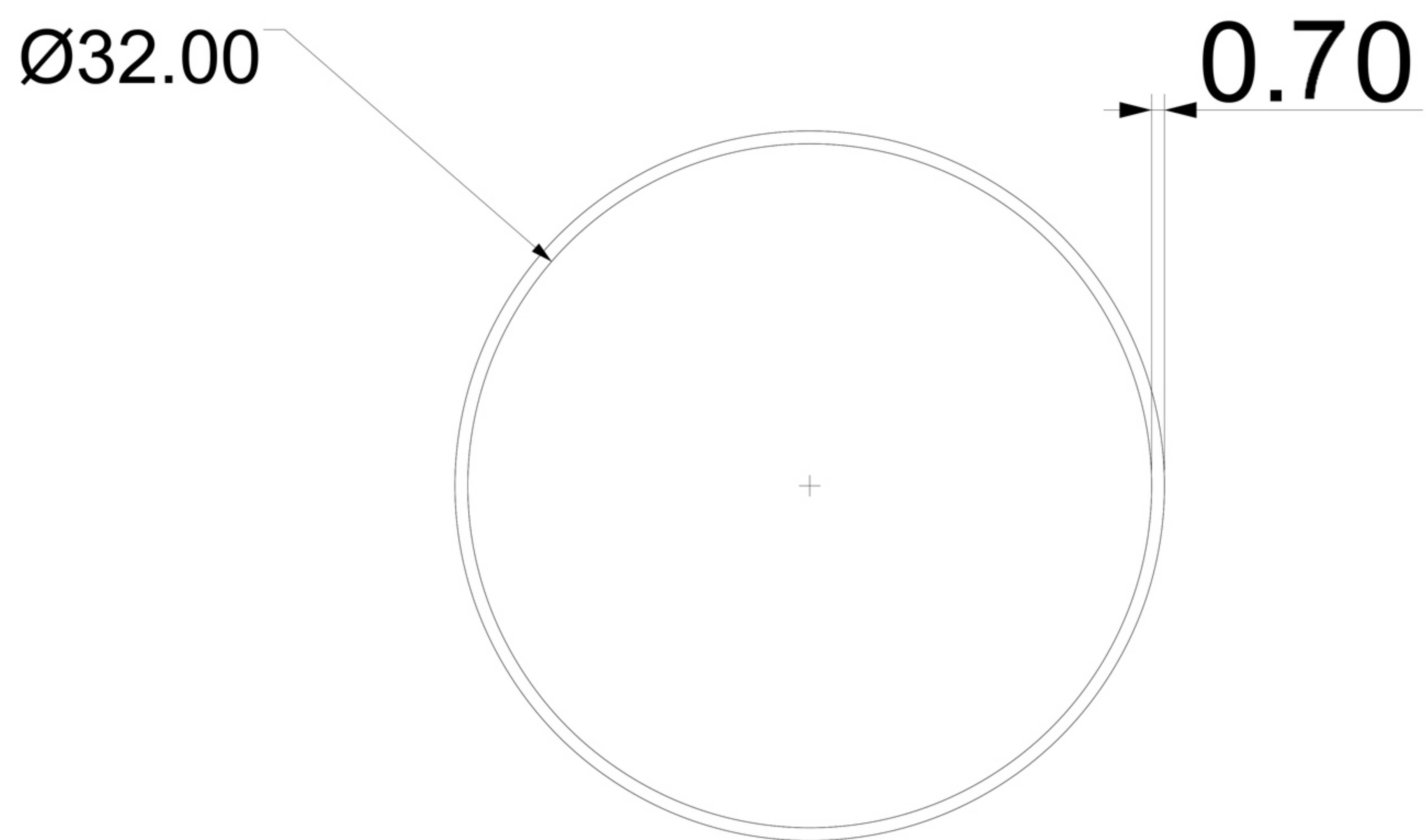
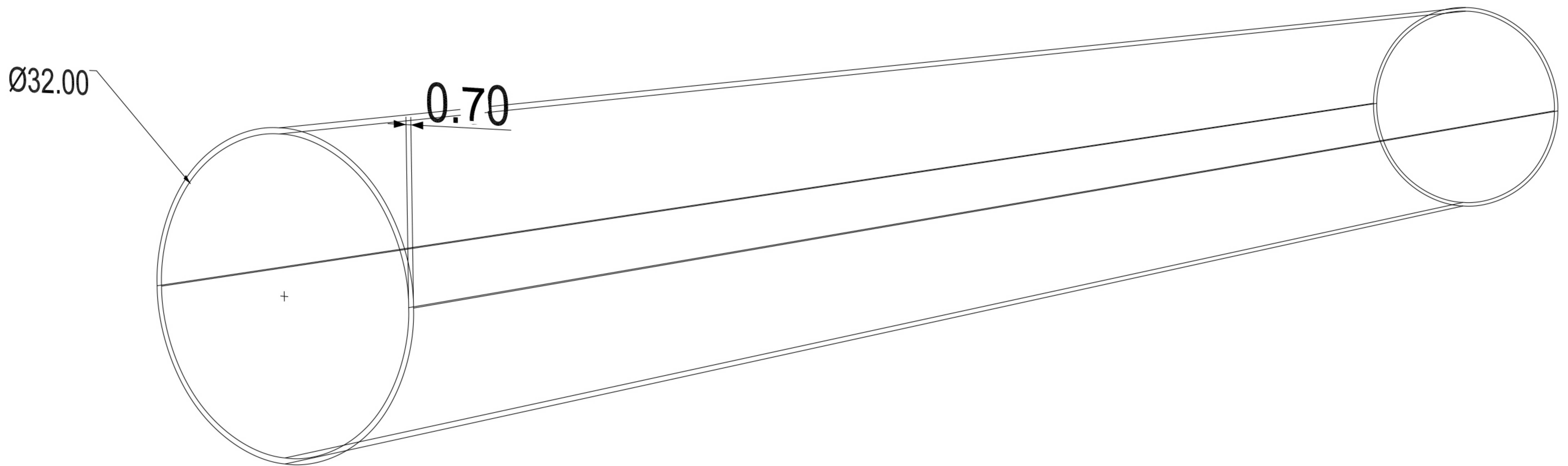
3. Photograph of 32mm curtain rod

As previously advised through the Vic sales team the products we are seeking fit the below specifications (we get them pre-packed and bar coded from China in 2m & 3m lengths)

- 16mm outside diameter in 0.4mm gauge/wall thickness powder-coated in White/Ivory/Black
- 25mm outside diameter in 0.5mm gauge/wall thickness in both powder-coated (White/Ivory/Black) and electroplated (Brushed Chrome).
- 32mm outside diameter in 0.7mm gauge/wall thickness in electroplated finish (Brushed Chrome).

What other technical specifications would you need? Or specific testing reports?

It would be great if you could get an indication from the mill about the realistic possibility of manufacture as we would be happy to see this done locally if it could work for both parties.

If it has potential we are happy to provide volumes etc.
