GRINDING BALLS EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

I write with regard to the public notice published on 14 July 2016 advising of your intention to review my decision (the Reviewable Decision) to terminate part of the countervailing investigation into grinding balls exported to Australia from China under subsection 269TDA(2) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission's (the Commission) website on 6 June 2016, referred to in Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2016/58.
