Notice under section 269ZZM(4)

Food Service and Industrial (FSI) Pineapple exported from the Kingdom of Thailand

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision made by me to publish a notice under section 269ZHG(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901* to secure the continuation of anti-dumping measures applicable to Food Service and Industrial Pineapple exported from the Kingdom of Thailand. This decision (Anti-Dumping Notice No. 2016/84) was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (the ADC) website on 13 September 2016.

An application for review was made by Kuiburi Fruit Canning Co., Ltd (Kuiburi). A copy of the application and the ADRP's report to me (ADRP Report No 50) is available on the ADRP website www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.

The ADRP has recommended that I revoke the reviewable decision as they apply to Kuiburi and substitute a decision not to secure the continuation of those anti-dumping measures on Kuiburi.

I, CRAIG LAUNDY, Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science, and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science, have considered and accept the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations made by the ADRP, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in ADRP Report No 50.

Therefore, in accordance with section 269ZZM(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901* I **revoke** the Reviewable Decision and substitute a new decision in the same terms as the Reviewable Decision except that the continuation of dumping measures do not apply to Kuiburi. This decision is taken to have effect from 13 September 2016.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Federal Court of Australia, in accordance with the requirements in the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977*, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.
