**RESEALABLE CAN END CLOSURES EXPORTED FROM MALAYSIA, THE  
REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES AND THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE.**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) review of the decision of the Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science to impose dumping duties on the export of resealable can end closures from Malaysia, the Republic of the Philippines and the Republic of Singapore (Reviewable Decision) was initiated on 8 May 2017. A copy of the public notice is attached.

To support the ADRP review, the ADRP Member requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

1. The Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) including any confidential attachments relevant to the grounds of the review application;
2. Any parties' submissions to the ADC commenting on the investigation including confidential attachments relevant to the grounds of the application for review;
3. All confidential attachments to the Report;

4. Confidential verification reports of exporters the subject of the investigation, together with confidential appendices and attachments; and
5. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicant, for example:
  - The confidential visit reports of the visits to Marpac Pty Ltd and the Visy Group;
  - Any other information relied on in making the decision the subject of the review relevant to the grounds of the application for review.

### **Confidential and Public Documents**

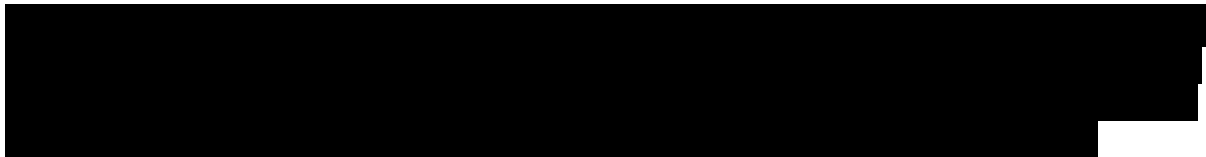
Only confidential versions of documents need to be provided. Public versions of documents that have been published on the ADC website, including on the Electronic Public Record for the relevant case, are not required.
