**Exported from the Federative Republic of Brazil, the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Indonesia and the Kingdom of Thailand**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has received an application from Paper Australia Pty Ltd dated 13 April 2017 for review of a decision ("Reviewable Decision") by the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission ("Commission") to terminate part of Investigation 341 into the alleged dumping and subsidisation of A4 copy paper exported to Australia. The part of the Investigation which was terminated related to goods exported:

1. by Pt Indah Kiat Pulp & Paper Tbk, Pt Pindo Deli Pulp and Paper Mills, Pt Pabrik Kertas Tjiwi Kimia Tbk ("Tjiwi Kimia") and Riau Andalan Kertas;
2. by the Republic of Indonesia; and
3. by UPM (China) Co., Ltd and UPM Asia Pacific Pte Ltd.

The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 17 March 2017 (ADN 2017/34).

The ADRP is satisfied that the following grounds are reasonable grounds for the Reviewable Decision not being the correct or preferable decision:

1. Subsidies received by Pt Indah Kiat Pulp and Paper Tbk, Pt Pindo Deli Pulp & Paper Mills, Tjiwi Kimia and Riau Andalan Kertas exceeded negligible levels during the investigation period;
2. the total volume of exports from Indonesia that received countervailable subsidies exceeded negligible levels;
3. goods exported by Tjiwi Kimia were dumped; and
4. Subsidies received by UPM (China) Co., Ltd and UPM Asia Pacific Pte Ltd were more than negligible.

The goods to which this review relates are:

Uncoated white paper of a type used for writing, printing or other graphic purposes, in the nominal basis weight range of 70 to 100gsm and cut to sheets of metric size A4 (210mm x 297mm) (also commonly referred to as cut sheet paper, copy paper, office paper or laser paper."

The goods have been classified to the following tariff subheadings:

- 4802.56.10, statistical code 03; and
- 4802.56.10, statistical code 09.
