Purpose

The purpose of this conference is to obtain further information in relation to the review before the ADRP, in relation to A4 Copy Paper exported from the Federative Republic of Brazil, the People’s Republic of China, the Republic of Indonesia and the Kingdom of Thailand.

In the course of this conference, I may ask parties to clarify an argument, claim or specific detail contained in the party’s application or submission. The conference is not a formal hearing of the review, and is not an opportunity for parties to argue their case before me.

I have only had regard to information provided at this conference that relates to relevant information (within the meaning of section 269ZZK(6) of the *Customs Act 1901*). Any conclusions reached at this conference are based on that relevant information.

Discussion

1. The Panel Member asked the Commission whether there was any evidence not specifically outlined in REP 341, which it relied upon to determine the sales between UPM-AP and Fuji Xerox were non arms-length?

The Commission provided copies of the confidential exporter and importer verification reports as well as the confidential submission from Fuji Xerox dated 3 June 2016 (pages 6-8) and also a copy of another importer’s verification work program, all of which it had considered.

2. The Panel Member indicated that the applicant refers to a submission dated 20 February 2017 (page 6 of application) in its review application, could this confidential submission be provided and in addition was it relied upon in REP 341. If so, where is it referred to please.

The Commission indicated that it had checked its records and the EPR and could not find a submission dated 20 February 2017 from Fuji Xerox.

The Panel Member indicated that she would seek clarification from the applicant.
