Dear Commissioner

Certain Prepared or Preserved Tomatoes Exported to Australia from the Republic of Italy by all exporters except Feger di Gerardo Ferraioli S.p.A (Feger), La Doria S.p.A (La Doria) and AR Industrie Alimentari S.p.A (ARIA) (ADN 2017/47) and Certain Prepared or Preserved Tomatoes Exported to Australia from the Republic of Italy by AR Industrie Alimentari S.p.A (ADN 2017/46)

On 11 July 2017, the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (“ADRP”) initiated a review of the Assistant Minister of Industry, Innovation and Science decision in Certain Prepared or Preserved Tomatoes exported to Australia from Italy by all exporters except Feger, La Doria and ARIA (ADN 2017/47) and Certain Prepared or Preserved Tomatoes Exported to Australia from Italy by ARIA (ADN 2017/46).

The ADRP has accepted applications from:

- SPC Ardmona Operations Ltd;
- Conserve Italia Soc. Coop. Agr.;
- Mutti S.p.A.; and
- Le Specialità Italiane Srl (LSI).

To support the ADRP review, the ADRP Member requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

1. The Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) including any confidential attachments relevant to the grounds of the review application.
2. Any parties' submissions to the ADC commenting on the SEF including confidential attachments relevant to the grounds of the application(s) for review.
3. The Final Report including confidential attachments.
4. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicant(s), for example:
 - If grounds relate to material injury/causal link please provide the verification visit report of the Australian industry and any confidential attachments.
 - If the grounds relate to normal value and or subsidy levels, please provide the export visit report, plus any confidential information/spreadsheets sent to the exporter regarding the calculation of the normal value, export price and dumping margins and/or subsidy and countervailing margins. A copy of information about the subsidy (ie any documents establishing the terms of and eligibility for the subsidy) should be provided.
 - If the grounds relate to export price please provide the exporter and importer visit reports and any confidential information/spreadsheets sent to the exporter and/or importer regarding dumping margins.

Confidential and Public Documents

Only confidential versions of documents need to be provided. Public versions of documents that have been published on the ADC website, including on the Electronic Public Record for the relevant case, are not required.

Due date for documents

The ADRP Member requests the ADC provide the documents by 18 July 2017.

Provision of documents

Documents are to be loaded to the ADRP extranet in this folder, noting the request as to naming protocols.
