

## **Anti-Dumping Review Panel - Conference Summary**

## **Purpose**

The purpose of this conference was to obtain further information in relation to the review currently before the ADRP, in relation to Certain Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel Exported from the People's Republic of China and the Republic of Korea and Certain Zinc Coated (Galvanised) Steel Exported from the People's Republic of China, Taiwan and the Republic of Korea.

In the course of this conference, I may have asked ADC representatives to clarify specific details relating to the calculation of export price. The conference was not a formal hearing of the review, and was not an opportunity for ADC representatives to argue their case before me.

I have only had regard to information provided at this conference that relates to relevant information (within the meaning of section 269ZZK(6) of the *Customs Act 1901*). Any conclusions reached at this conference are based on that relevant information.

## Discussion

Discussion focused upon the content of an email from the ADC to the ADRP Secretariat dated 9 October 2017, following up on an earlier conference dated 6 October 2017. This email highlighted certain issues arising from any re-ascertainment of export price. These included the following possible consequential considerations:

- In the event of a negative dumping margin, ensuring that there is no over collection of duty because of the operation of the combination duty method; and
- Possible minor variation to the normal value and the NIP due to differences in timing and the product mix of the goods exported to Australia during the review period and the goods sold by CITIC during the review period.

It was agreed that the ADC would incorporate the above-mentioned consequential variations in calculations to be submitted to the Review Panel.
