**Power Transformers Exported to Australia from the Republic of Indonesia by PT  
CG Power Systems, Indonesia**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (“ADRP”) has received an application from PT CG Power Systems (“CG Power”) for review of a decision by the Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science (“Minister”) to publish a notice altering the variable factors relevant to the determination of dumping duty such that the rate of interim dumping duty was 43.3%.

The grounds raised in CG Power’s application for the review are:

- (a) when calculating the normal value, the Minister erred in determining the amount of profit;
- (b) the Minister made incorrect adjustments to the normal value; and
- (c) the Minister wrongly altered the variable factors when there had been no export sales of the goods to Australia since the variable factors were ascertained on 10 December 2014.

The goods to which this application relates are:

*liquid dielectric power transformers with power ratings of equal to or greater than 10 mega volt amperes and a voltage rating of less than 500 kilo volts whether assembled or unassembled, complete or incomplete.*

Interested parties have 30 days from the date this notice is published to provide the Review Panel with a submission.

If your submission contains confidential information you must provide a public version that can be published on the ADRP website. Failure to do so will result in your submission not being considered.
