Purpose

The purpose of this conference was to obtain further information in relation to the review before the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) in relation to certain aluminium extrusions exported from Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam and certain aluminium extrusions exported from Malaysia.

In the course of this conference, I may have asked the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) to clarify an argument, calculation or specific detail contained in Report No. 362 (REP 362), related document, submission of further information provided to the ADRP arising from a previous conference. The conference was not a formal hearing of the review, and was not an opportunity for parties to argue their case before me.

I have only had regard to information provided at this conference as it relates to relevant information (within the meaning of section 269ZZK(6) of the *Customs Act 1901*). Any conclusions reached at this conference are based on that relevant information. Information that relates to some new argument not previously put in REP 362 or submission is not something that the ADRP has regard to, and is therefore not reflected in this conference summary.

Discussion

The specific information that the ADRP sought in this conference was clarification relating to the further information furnished by the ADC arising from the Conference held on 8 November 2017 (the First Conference):

1. The Reviewing Member (RM) sought clarification of the further information provided by the ADC, arising out of the First Conference, in relation to Figure 10 of REP 362.
 - The ADC Representative (AR) confirmed that the blue data line in Figure 10 labelled, “Malaysia Dumped” did not include data in relation to Malaysian goods from exporters whose dumping and subsidy margins were below negligible levels, that is, it related only to data from the uncooperative exporters.
 - With regard to a clarification requested by the RM concerning Figure 10 and Confidential Attachment 13 (containing the source data), the AR confirmed that the red data line in Figure 10 does not represent all the “undumped” imports from Malaysia. The AR stated that the red data line, however, represented a major portion of the undumped exports.¹
 - The RM requested further clarification on the reference in the source data worksheet to, “Malaysia - All other exporters”. The AR confirmed that this was a reference to the uncooperative exporters and that it did not include any data from exporters whose margins were below negligible levels. The AR confirmed that this data formed the basis of the blue data line labelled, “Malaysia – Dumped” in Figure 10.
