The reinvestigation report in relation to HSS is currently due to the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) by Monday, 20 November 2017. As you are aware, I was provided with a timeframe of 44 days to conduct a reinvestigation of certain findings and report to the ADRP as required.

I request an extension of 70 days to Monday, 29 January 2018, to provide this report to the ADRP. I request this extension on the following grounds:

- Some of the issues raised are complex and I consider that your review would benefit from a thorough explanation of the Commission's view of these issues.
- The Commission's current workload means that the reinvestigation case manager is unable to devote himself solely to this task until mid December 2017.
- A number of workdays will be lost in December and January due to the Commission's office shutdown during that period.
