**Certain Zinc Coated (Galvanised Steel)**  
**Exported from the Republic of India, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has received an application from BlueScope Steel Limited dated 15 August 2017 for review of a decision (“Reviewable Decision”) by the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (“Commission”) to terminate part of Investigation 370 into the alleged dumping of zinc coated (galvanised) steel (“goods”) exported to Australia from the Republic of India, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (“Vietnam”) and the alleged subsidisation of the goods exported to Australia from India and Vietnam. The parts of the Investigation which were terminated were:

1. the alleged dumping of goods exported by Hoa Sen Group (“Hoa Sen”) and Nam Kim Steel Joint Stock Company from Vietnam; and
2. the subsidisation of goods exported from Vietnam.

The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 17 July 2017 ([ADN 2017/98](#)).

The ADRP is satisfied that the following are reasonable grounds for the Reviewable Decision not being the correct or preferable decision:

1. The Commission wrongly failed to determine that a market situation existed in the domestic galvanised steel market in Vietnam, such that selling prices in that market are not suitable for ascertaining the normal value;
2. The Commission wrongly determined normal values for the Hoa Sen normal value on the basis only of sales of that entity’s Di An branch;
3. The Commissioner wrongly failed to make an adjustment to Hoa Sen’s normal value for export credit.

The goods to which this review relates are:

Flat rolled iron or steel goods (whether or not containing alloys) that are plated or coated with zinc. The goods are also generically described as galvanised steel. Galvanised steel of any width is included in this application.

The goods have been classified to the following tariff subheadings:

- 7210.49.00 Statistical Codes 55, 56, 57 and 58
- 7212.30.00 Statistical Code 61
- 7225.92.00, Statistical Code 38

- 7226.99.00 Statistical Code 71
