# Alloy Round Bar exported from the People's Republic of China Application by: OneSteel Manufacturing Pty Ltd

Please be advised that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has initiated a review of your decision on 27 October 2017 to terminate part of the investigation into the alleged dumping of Alloy Round Bar exported from the People's Republic of China.

For the purpose of obtaining further information in relation to the review, the ADRP Member requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

- 1. Any confidential attachments to the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) (relevant to the grounds of the review application (assuming the SEF will otherwise be on the public record)
- 2. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicant, for example:
  - Documents relevant to the construction of the normal value for the exports of Jiangsu Yonggang Group Co. Ltd (Yonggang), including any export visit report, plus any confidential information/spreadsheets regarding the calculation of the normal value.

- Confidential correspondence or submissions regarding the construction of the normal value for Yonggang's exports.
- 3. Any other confidential records/documents that contain information relevant to the construction of Yonggang's normal value.

## **Confidential Applications**

I attach confidential versions of the applications submitted to the ADRP.

### **Confidential and Public ADC Documents**

Only confidential versions of documents need to be provided. Public versions of documents that have been published on the ADC website, including on the Electronic Public Record for the relevant case, are not required.
