**Alloy Round Bar exported from the People's Republic of China ([ADN 2017/152](#))**

I refer to the decision of the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission on 27 October 2017 to terminate part of the anti-dumping investigation (Investigation 384) into alloy round bar exported from the People's Republic of China so far as it related to Jiangsu Yonggang Group Co., Ltd (Yonggang Group).

As you were nominated by Yonggang Group as its representative for the purpose of investigation 384, I am writing to you to advise that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel has received an application for review of the Commissioner's decision from OneSteel Manufacturing Pty Ltd. I also advise that consideration of this application has been delayed pending the final report of the Commissioner with respect to Investigation 384.

In Statement of Essential Facts No. 384, the Commissioner indicated an intention to terminate Investigation 384 in accordance with s.269TDA(13) of the *Customs Act 1901* on the ground of negligible injury. Given the effect which such a decision could have on any review of the decision to terminate the investigation with respect to Yonggang Group, I have notified the applicant and the Commission that I will await the Commissioner's final report before making a decision on whether or not to initiate a review.

I note that unless investigation 384 is terminated sooner, the report to the Parliamentary Secretary is due by 19 January 2018.
