Notice under section 269ZZI

Hot Rolled Coil exported from Japan, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) received applications from Chung Hung Steel Corporation, Shang Chen Steel Co., Ltd and China Steel Corporation (the Applicants) for a review of the former Assistant Minister/Parliamentary Secretary's decision to secure the continuation of the anti-dumping measures in respect of Hot Rolled Coil (HRC) exported to Australia from Japan, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan (the Reviewable Decision).

The former Assistant Minister/Parliamentary Secretary's decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 18 December 2017.

The ADRP is satisfied that the following grounds are reasonable grounds for the reviewable decision not being the correct or preferable decision:

- (a) The ADC erred in finding that future exports by the Applicants of HRC were likely to be exported at dumped prices in the absence of measures; and
- (b) The ADC erred in finding that future exports by the Applicants of HRC were likely lead to a recurrence of material injury in the absence of measures.

The goods to which these applications relate are: HRC (including in sheet form), a flat rolled product of iron or non-alloy steel, not clad, plated or coated (other than oil coated). Goods excluded are hot rolled products that have patterns in relief (known as checker plate) and plate products.

The ADRP proposes to conduct a review of the decision.

Interested parties have **30 days** from the date this notice is published to provide the ADRP with a submission.

If your submission contains confidential information, you must provide a public version that can be published on the ADRP website. Failure to do so will result in your submission not being considered.
