Alloy Round Bar exported from the People's Republic of China
Application by: OneSteel Manufacturing Pty Ltd

Please be advised that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) Review No. 75: Alloy Round Bar exported from the People's Republic of China was initiated on 8 March 2018.

The applicant seeking review of the Commissioners decision to terminate Investigation 384 under subsection 269TDA(13) of the *Customs Act 1901* is OneSteel Manufacturing Pty Ltd.

For the purpose of obtaining further information in relation to the review, the ADRP Member requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

1. Any confidential attachments to the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) (relevant to the grounds of the review application (assuming the SEF will otherwise be on the public record).

3. Any confidential attachments to the Final Report (assuming the full Final Report will otherwise be on the public record).
4. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicant(s), for example:

- the verification visit reports for the Australian industry and any confidential attachments.
 - the importer visit reports and any confidential information/spreadsheets.
 - confidential correspondence and other confidential documents not on the EPR.
5. Any other records/documents that contain information about the verification report/s.

Confidential and Public ADC Documents

Only confidential versions of documents need to be provided. Public versions of documents that have been published on the ADC website, including on the Electronic Public Record for the relevant case, are not required.
