**Steel Reinforcing Bar exported from the People's Republic of China**

Please be advised that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has initiated a review of a decision by the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Jobs and Innovation following a review of anti-dumping measures in respect of Steel Reinforcing Bar exported from the People's Republic of China by Jiangsu Shagang Group Co., Ltd, Hunan Valin Xiangtan Iron & Steel Co., Ltd and Jiangsu Yonggang Group Co., Ltd.
