Notice under section 269ZZM(1B)

Certain Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel exported from the People's Republic of China

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of the decision made by the former Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Jobs and Innovation (former Parliamentary Secretary) to vary the variable factors in respect of the dumping duty notice applying to Certain Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel exported from the People's Republic of China by Baoshan Iron & Steel Co., Ltd and Shanghai Meishan Iron & Steel Co., Ltd.

The ADRP provided its report and recommendation to the former Parliamentary Secretary on 13 August 2018.

Subsection 269ZZM(1A) of the *Customs Act 1901* requires that I must make a decision in regard to that report and its recommendation within 30 days after receiving that report. This would require me to make my decision by 12 September 2018, unless I consider special circumstances prevent my decision being made within that period. If I do consider that such special circumstances exist, the decision may be made within such longer period as I consider appropriate.

I am satisfied that there are special circumstances that prevent the decision under section 269ZZM being made on 12 September 2018. Accordingly, I have decided under section 269ZZM(1A)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901* to extend the period for making my decision to 12 October 2018.
