**Certain Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel exported from the People's Republic of China
Applications for Review by: Baoshan Iron & Steel Co., Ltd and Shanghai Meishan Iron & Steel
Co., Ltd**

As you may be aware, on 13 June 2018 the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Panel) initiated a review of the decision by the Assistant Minister for Science, Jobs and Innovation / Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Jobs and Innovation under subsection 269ZDB(1)(a)(iii) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect of Certain Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel exported from the People's Republic of China by Baoshan Iron & Steel Co., Ltd (Baosteel) and Shanghai Meishan Iron & Steel Co., Ltd (Meisteel) (Reviewable Decision).

The Reviewable Decision dealt with two reviews under Division 5 of Part XVB of the Act, Review 409 (in respect of Baosteel) and Review 410 (in respect of Meishan).

For the purpose of obtaining further information in relation to the review, the Panel Member requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

2. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicants.
3. Any other records/documents that contain information about the verification reports (including, for example, the work programmes).
