Notice under section 269ZZI

Certain Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel exported from the People's Republic of China

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) received applications from Baoshan Iron & Steel Co., Ltd (Baosteel) and Shanghai Meishan Iron & Steel Co., Ltd (Meisteel) for a review of a decision of the Assistant Minister for Science, Jobs and Innovation / Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Jobs and Innovation (Minister) under subsection 269ZDB(1)(a)(iii) of the *Customs Act 1901* (Act) to vary the variable factors relevant to the determination of anti-dumping and countervailing measures in respect of Certain Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel exported from the People's Republic of China (Reviewable Decision) by the applicants.

The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 30 April 2018 and was the subject of Anti-Dumping Notice [2018/54](#).

The ADRP is satisfied that the following grounds are reasonable grounds for the Reviewable Decision not being the correct or preferable decision in respect of the applications of both Baosteel and Meisteel:

- (i) the Minister erred in retrospectively applying the amendments to the Act effected by the *Customs Amendment (Anti-Dumping Measures) Act 2018*; and
- (ii) the Minister made incorrect assessments and determinations under s 269TAB(2A) with respect to the exports.

The goods to which the applications relate are:

flat rolled products of iron and non-alloy steel of a width equal to or greater than 600mm, plated or coated with aluminium-zinc alloys, not painted whether or not including resin coating

The goods are classified to the tariff subheading 7210.61.00 (statistical codes 60, 61 and 62) in Schedule 3 to the *Customs Tariff Act 1995*.

The ADRP proposes to conduct a review of the Reviewable Decision.

Interested parties have **30 days** from the date this notice is published to provide the ADRP with a submission.
