Certain Hollow Structural Sections exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan

Please be advised that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has initiated a review of a decision by the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Jobs and Innovation following a review of anti-dumping measures in respect of Certain Hollow Structural Sections exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan.
