Notice under section 269ZZM(4)

**Certain Hollow Structural Sections exported from the People’s Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan**

On 31 May 2018, the then Assistant Minister for Science, Jobs and Innovation made a decision to vary the variable factors in respect of Certain Hollow Structural Sections exported from the People’s Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 6 June 2018 (ADN 2018/74). Applications for review of the Reviewable Decision were made by:

- Tianjin Youfa Steel Pipe Group Co., Ltd (Tianjin Youfa);
- Dalian Steelforce Hi-Tech Co., Ltd (Dalian); and
- Ursine Steel Co., Ltd (Ursine).

On 25 March 2019, following a review by the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP), I made a decision under subsection 269ZZM(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* to accept the ADRP’s recommendations (made in ADRP Report No 88) and revoked the Reviewable Decision in so far as it related to Tianjin Youfa and Dalian (the Decision). The Decision resulted in an adjustment to the export price for Dalian, resulting in a dumping margin for Dalian of 10.5% and an adjustment to the normal value for Tianjin Youfa, resulting in a dumping margin for Tianjin Youfa of 10.9%.

Subsequently, a clerical error was identified in the Decision as it relates to Tianjin Youfa. The specified dumping margin of 10.9% was incorrect and should have stated 10.7%. Accordingly, a further substituted decision was required in order to correct the error.

I, KAREN ANDREWS, Minister for Industry, Science and Technology, in accordance with section 269ZZM(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901*, revoke the reviewable decision and substitute a new decision that an adjustment be made to the normal value for Tianjin Youfa, resulting in a dumping margin for Tianjin Youfa of 10.7 per cent. My decision, as it relates to Tianjin Youfa, is to have effect from 4 April 2019.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Federal Court of Australia, in accordance with the requirements in the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977*, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.
