ADRP Review No. 100 – Wind Towers exported from the People’s Republic of China and the Republic of Korea

Application by: Shanghai Taisheng Wind Power Equipment Co., Ltd

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has initiated a review of the decision of the Minister to publish a notice under Section 269ZH(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of Wind Towers exported from the People’s Republic of China and the Republic of Korea.

For the purpose of obtaining further information in relation to the review, the ADRP Member requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

- The confidential version of the Australian Industry Verification Report (No. 009 of EPR 487), including any confidential attachments.
 - The confidential version of Shanghai Taisheng Wind Power Equipment Co. Ltd's Exporter Verification Report (No. 013 of EPR 487), including any confidential information or spreadsheets sent to the exporter regarding the calculation of the normal value, export price and dumping margins.
 - Any other records/documents that contain information about the verification report/s.
