Notice under section 269ZZM(1B)

Wind Towers exported from the People's Republic of China and the Republic of Korea

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision which I, KAREN ANDREWS, Minister for Industry, Science and Technology made under subsection 269ZHG(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect of Wind Towers exported from the People's Republic of China (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 27 March 2019 (ADN 2019/33).

On 6 April 2020, the ADRP made its report to me in accordance with section 269ZZK of the Act. Subsection 269ZZM(1A) of the Act requires that I must make a decision within 30 days after receiving that report, unless I consider special circumstances prevent my decision being made within that period. If I do consider that such special circumstances exist, the decision may be made within such longer period as I consider appropriate.

I am satisfied that there are special circumstances that prevent a decision under section 269ZZM(1) being made within 30 days. Accordingly, I have decided under section 269ZZM(1A)(b) of the Act to extend the period for making my decision to 6 July 2020.
