ADRP Review No 100 – Wind Towers exported from the People’s Republic of China and the Republic of Korea (Case 487)

The reinvestigation report in relation to Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) Review No. 100 of wind towers was initially due to the ADRP by Monday, 2 September 2019. As you are aware, the Commissioner was provided with an initial timeframe of 60 days to conduct a reinvestigation of certain findings and report to the ADRP as required. The Commissioner sought, and was granted, an extension of time of 60 days to provide the reinvestigation report to the ADRP. The reinvestigation report is currently due to be provided to the ADRP by Friday, 1 November 2019.

I request a further extension of 95 days to Monday 4 February 2020, to provide this report to the ADRP. I request this second extension on the following grounds:

- The issues raised in the reinvestigation request and submissions to the preliminary reinvestigation report are complex and require detailed analysis to establish the appropriate normal value, and;
- The impact of the Christmas and New Year period.
