ADRP Review No 100 – Wind Towers exported from the People’s Republic of China and the Republic of Korea (Case 487)

The reinvestigation report in relation to Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) Review No. 100 of wind towers is currently due to the ADRP by Monday, 2 September 2019. As you are aware, the Commissioner was provided with a timeframe of 60 days to conduct a reinvestigation of certain findings and report to the ADRP as required.

I request an extension of 60 days to Friday, 1 November 2019, to provide this report to the ADRP. I request this extension on the following grounds:

- The issues raised in the reinvestigation request are complex and require detailed analysis to establish the appropriate normal value; and,
- Due to the complexities involved, I propose to publish a preliminary reinvestigation report and seek submissions on this report to allow interested parties procedural fairness.
